Tad motion to adopt the rule and regulation regarding beginning construction subject to revisions discussed in 11-12-14 BoD meeting; Seconded by Greg. Passed Unanimously

Motion will be effective 30 days after filing with Gallatin County Clerk & Recorder

## VI. Capital Improvements

Community garden-area north of Brenden has space for community garden plots; members of the HOA Committee have already built plots; Greg will confer with Greater Gallatin regarding the cost to bring irrigation to the area and build the trail north of Brenden and through the garden area; Greg will bring figures to spring BoD meeting for further discussion

HOA residents would pay a fee to the HOA to rent their plot on an annual basis in perpetuity
